Welcome to Mcely!

We are happy to welcome you all to Mcely in September 2020. This is the first time Mcely will host a riders camp. You will have an opportunity to ride on the wooden track that is specifically built for the training for Ice Cross. The final highlight of the event will be a duel race (more info below).

Mcely is a very small village in the middle of the Czech Republic. There you have all the silence and peace to concentrate your mind for the upcoming Ice Cross season.

We would like to make this event even more exciting with the support from Red Bull CZ, but that depends on the number of international participants. A good number for this to happen would be around 20-30 international riders.

Duel Race

Time trial

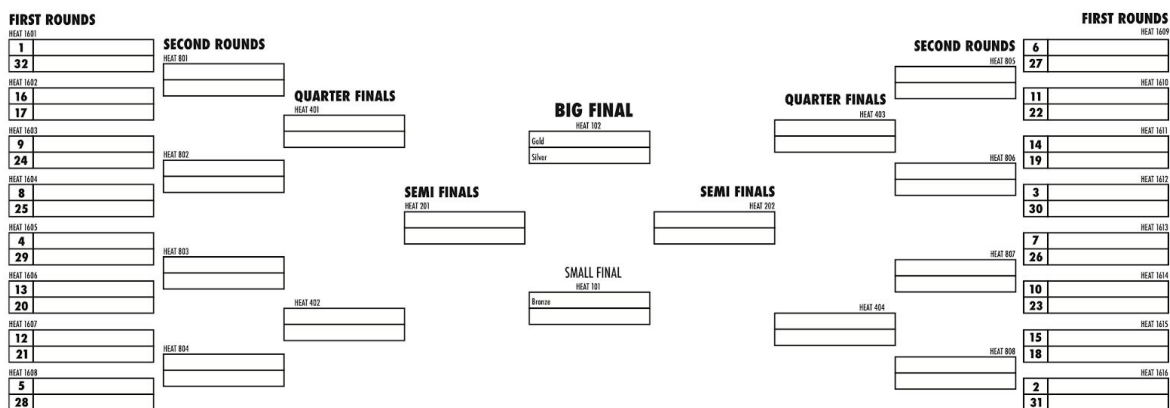
- Race format is solo run
- The starting order of the timed run is determined according to the order in which riders check-in on site.
- The women's category will be run first, followed by men.
- Each rider shall get at least 1 timed run. Starting in all timed runs is mandatory.
- If a rider runs off track, he can get back on the track and try to finish the race as long as he doesn't get an advantage by leaving the track. Short cuts lead to disqualification.
- The race director has the final call on rider disqualification.
- 32 riders per category progress to the knock-out heat finals.
 - if there are 31 and less riders in a category, 16 riders qualify for the knock-out heat finals.
 - if there are 15 and less riders in a category, 8 riders qualify for the knock-out heats finals.
 - if there are 7 and less riders in a category, 4 riders qualify for the knock-out heats finals.

Heat finals

- Rider pairings will be determined based on their ranking following the timed runs. The fastest rider (1st placed) will go head to head against the slowest rider (8th / 16th / 32nd placed). See bracket example below.
- The fastest rider from each heat advances to the next round, until there are only 2 riders remaining who will in the Big Final

Running order (example top 32)

- Women's round, followed by men's round
- First round = top 32
- Second round = top 16
- Quarter final = top 8
- Semi final
- Small final
- Big final
